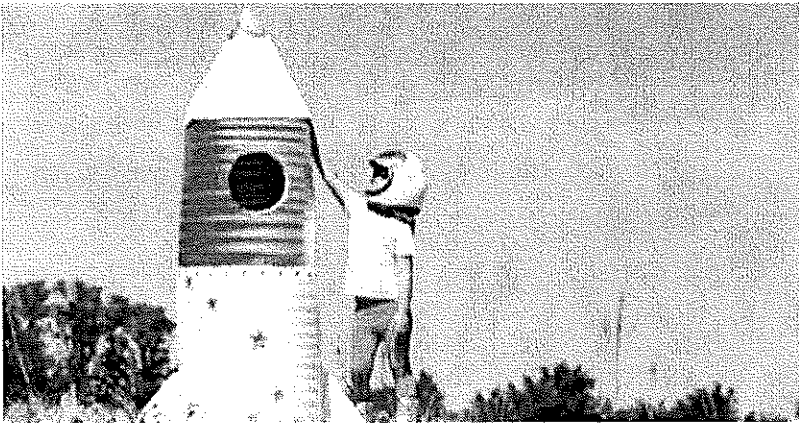


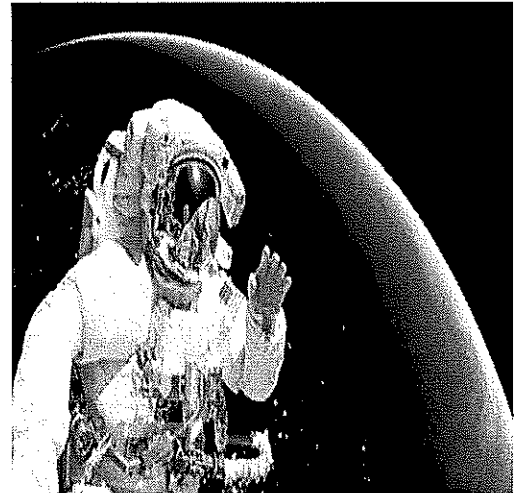
A Girl With Many Talents: Mae Jemison



In 1987, Mae was accepted into NASA's astronaut program. She became one of 15 astronauts selected from a group of 2,000!

She trained in Texas, learning about space exploration and how to be an astronaut. In August of 1988, Mae completed her astronaut training.

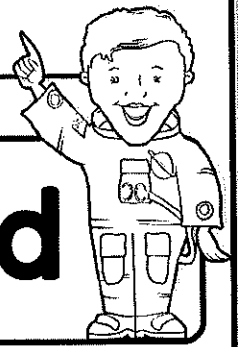
On the first day of Kindergarten, Mae Jemison's teacher asked her what she wanted to be when she grew up. Mae confidently told her, "A scientist!" Even from an early age, Mae was curious and brave. Mae loved to read and learned about the universe through books. This curiosity led her to become the first black woman astronaut.



As a young woman, Mae was active in school government, acted in plays and studied dance. In college, she studied science, learned different languages, and eventually became a doctor.


