2018-19 Goals

Setting goals is a standard practice for any organization. Alloway Township School's goals align with the district's mission statement. The goals set for the 2018-19 school year are based on qualitative and quantitative data. These goals are set in order to guide deliberate decision-making and intentional action. The Goals Committee (CSA, BS, BOE President, and BOE Vice-President) met to finalize goals for the both Board and the Superintendent.

2018-19 Goal #1: Student Achievement

The district's mission statement describes the school as an academic institution that aims to facilitate lifelong learning. The school will not only provide students with equal opportunities to achieve individually defined excellence but will also expect that students master the skills stipulated in the grade-level math and language arts literacy standards. The mission statement further describes how the district will provide quality programs and educators who are skilled and knowledgeable about both the standards and professional best practices. Student achievement is defined and measured based on individual levels of preparedness. Programs and instruction are tailored to suit individual student needs.

District/Board's Goal- The Alloway Township School Board of Education will support the district's mission to promote academic growth. The Board will frame district decisions regarding programs, personnel, funding, and resources with 'promoting student achievement' as determined by level of preparedness as the primary consideration.

CSA's Goal- The CSA will develop a strategy to raise the school's % of students who meet/exceed expectations on the state-mandated PARCC assessments so that the school either matches or surpasses the % of students who meet/exceed expectations at the state level.

2018-19 Goal #2: Communication

District leadership recognizes the impact of communication on the school community. In order to leverage the impact of community and parent involvement, a comprehensive approach to communication would encompass various platforms and methods. The school is committed to providing effective communication.

District/Board's Goal- In order to support the district's mission, the Alloway Township Board of Education will advocate for and facilitate comprehensive communication for its various stakeholders.

CSA's Goal- The CSA will develop a comprehensive plan that includes a variety of communication platforms. The CSA will utilize the platforms of communication for school business which includes both disseminating and gathering information.



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2018-19 Goal #3: Strategic Plan

One of the core beliefs shared among district leadership is that the organization must define its destination and plan a cohesive strategy to intentionally arrive at that desired destination. School districts utilize the strategic planning process to deliberately outline the points of pride, hopes for the future, and an action plan to bring the hopes to fruition. Strategic planning involves all stakeholders and provides a 3-year framework for long-term goals and planning.

District/Board's Goal- The Alloway Township School Board of Education will empower the School Improvement Team (SIT) to guide the strategic planning process and will use their leadership role to support the process.

CSA's Goal- The CSA will lead the SIT to steer the district's stakeholders through the strategic planning process during the 2018-19 school year. The CSA will facilitate the SIT to write the plan to be recommended for Board approval in June 2019.
